Belrose Touch will set up signage at Lionel Watts To limit crowds, we will advise parents to not attend games and rely on one manager per team to minimize the risk of transmission.
Provide staff and volunteers with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing and cleaning, and how to manage a sick visitor.	 Belrose Touch will provide all members with COVID-19 safety protocols and checklists including the need (where applicable) for testing, contact tracing, social/physical distancing, cleaning and hygiene, as well as managing sick visitors, or participants (of all types) who become sick/ill during training or play. Volunteer staff will be briefed on Covid Safe practices and protocols.
